Opened in 2010, the Ralph Regula federal building was constructed to replace two facilities: the 70year old Frank T. Bow Federal Building and the Social Security Administration. The 45,000 square-foot space is composed of two brick buildings connected by a 34-foot-high glass-atrium lobby. The new building is LEED silver certified.

Hilscher-Clarke's scope of work involved the electrical and communications portions of the project. Our dedicated electricians installed the audio and video/ controls systems, security wiring, interior and exterior lighting, wiring devices, floor boxes, generator and automatic transfer switch, elevator wiring, fire alarm
