Marathon 2018 Major Turnaround

In 2018, the Canton Marathon Refinery commenced a 60-day full plant shutdown with the help of Hilscher-Clarke. During the outage, Hilscher-Clarke had an on-site max crew of 130 skilled electricians, which included 100 on days and 30 on nights. Our responsibilities included providing temporary lighting and power for all trades in all plant areas. We also performed work in CL1D1, CL1D2, and non-classified areas. Our dedicated electricians installed instrumentation process tubing and completed the installation of heat trace systems per manufacturer and customer specifications. Upon start-up, loop checks were performed by a team of 20 HC instrumentation technicians. Throughout the project, dedicated safety and QA/QC personnel were on site. Hilscher-Clarke worked approximately 58,000 man hours to complete the job to ensure critical target dates were met or exceeded.
